### FASTING FOR HOLY COMMUNION

The Holy Communion is one of the important sacraments for the salvation of Christians and for the nourishment of our souls. Holy Communion is a sacrament by which the believer receives Christ's Body and Blood in the form of bread and wine for remission of sins and the reception of eternal life. It is offered to the faithful during the celebration of Badarak.

For a person in good health, it is necessary to fast, abstain from food and participate in the sacrament of Confession before receiving Holy Communion. For those of ill health who are on special medication, a light breakfast is permitted. For the evening Badarak, fasting should begin after the midday meal and continue until the evening Badarak has been celebrated.

"So Jesus said to them, "Very truly, I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day; for my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink. Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood abide in me, and I in them." (John 6:53-56)

### MAS

MAS (Antidoron) is very thin unleavened bread of wheat, of any reasonable size making it possible to be baked on a metal tray. It can be made by any member of the congregation. It is distributed after the Liturgy to those of the congregation who have not received communion. It is customary to take mas to the members of one's family and to friends, who have been unable to attend the Liturgy. Mas symbolizes the bond of love among the members of the church.

Mas, meaning "a portion", represents the remaining part if the loaf which the faithful used to bring to Church in ancient times to be used as bread for the Eucharist. A fraction (nshkhar) of this loaf was taken to consecration, while the remainder was distributed among the congregation at the end of the Liturgy.

### THE HOLY APOSTLES PETER AND PAUL

**ST. PETER**, the son of Jonah and brother of Andrew the First-Called, of the tribe of Simon and the town of Bethsaida, was a fisherman and was at first called Simon, but the Lord called him Cephas, or Peter (Jn 1:42). He was the first of the disciples to give clear expression to his faith in the Lord Jesus, saying: "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Mt 16:16).

Peter's honored position comes out clearly in a high point of Jesus' ministry, when he, together with James and John, was chosen to see the Transfiguration. After the Last Supper he, again with James and John, witnessed Jesus' agony in Gethsemane. When the Lord was put on trial, Peter denied him three times, but it needed only one look into the face of the Lord, and Peter's soul was filled with shame and repentance. After the descent of the Holy Spirit, Peter became a fearless preacher of the Gospel. Following his sermon in Jerusalem, about 3,000 souls were converted. He preached the Gospel throughout Palestine and Asia Minor, in Italy and Illyria.

Peter was condemned to death on the order of the Emperor Nero. After installing Linus as Bishop of Rome and exhorting and encouraging the flock of Christ there, Peter went to his death with joy. When he saw the cross before him, he asked to be crucified upside-down for he felt himself unworthy to die in the same way as the Lord. He is traditionally regarded as the first bishop of Rome.

**ST. PAUL** was born in Tarsus. He is the second most important founder of Christianity, also called the thirteenth Apostle. He was formerly known as Saul. He was wondrously converted by the Lord Himself, who appeared to him on the road to Damascus. As Saul was knocked to the ground, a heavenly light shone down suddenly from heaven. He heard Jesus Christ's voice, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" (Acts 9:4). After his conversion, Paul preached the Gospel everywhere with burning zeal, from the borders of Arabia to the land of Spain among the Jews and the heathen, receiving the title of "The Apostle to the Gentiles."

The apostle Paul was executed in Rome during the time of the emperor Nero. He was beheaded at the same time as St. Peter.

### NAME DAY CELEBRATIONS

Whenever you know a friend or loved one whose Name Day/Feast Day is soon to be celebrated, honor the person by presenting them with a lit candle saying, "Anoonovut abrees" or "Anoonovut dzeranas" ("May you grow old with your name"). Or you can simply say, "Happy Name Day!"

Learn and sing beautiful melodies of the Armenian Church and enjoy the fellowship. We will sing hymns and songs of various daily hours, sacraments and special services of the Armenian Church.

St. Romanos was one of the greatest and most original of the early church hymnographers, and is referred to by some as "the greatest Christian poet". Very little is known of his life. He was born in Emesa (modern Homs), Syria, probably of Jewish parents (although this s not certain). From Homs he went to Beryte (modern Beirut), where he was deacon in the Church of the Resurrection. He then became a priest in Constantinople, where he received the gift of poetry in the church of the Theotokos (Kyros).

St. Romanos introduced hymnography into the Eastern Liturgy, which was of Syro-Palestinian origin. He wrote a classical form of hymn with a long and elaborate metrical dramatic homily which usually paraphrases a Biblical narrative. He is credited with writing many beautiful hymns that have had an impact on Armenian hymnology.

# Isaiah 40:18-31

To whom then will you liken god, or what likeness compare with you? The idol! a workman casts it, and a goldsmith overlays it with gold, and casts for it silver chains. He who is impoverished chooses for an offering wood that will not rot; he seeks out a skilful craftsman to set up an image that will not move.

Have you not known? Have you not heard? Has it not been told you from the beginning? Have you not understood from the foundations of the earth? It is he who sits above the circle of the earth, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers; who stretches out the heavens like a curtain, and spreads them like a tent to dwell in; who brings princes to nought, and makes the rulers of the earth as nothing.

Scarcely are they planted, scarcely sown, scarcely has their stem taken root in the earth, when he blows upon them, and they wither, and the tempest carries them off like stubble. To whom then will you compare me, that I should be like him? says the Holy One.

Lift up your eyes on high and see: who created these? He who brings out their host by number, calling them all by name; by the greatness of his might, and because he is strong in power not one is missing.

Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel, "My way is hid from the Lord, and my right is disregarded by my God?" Have you not known? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary, his understanding is unsearchable. He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength.

Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

### Hebrews 4:16-5:10

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

For every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He can deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is beset with weakness. Because of this he is bound to offer sacrifice for his own sins as well as for those of the people. And one does not take the honor upon himself, but he is called by God, just as Aaron was.

So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him.

"You are my Son, today I have begotten you;" as he says also in another place,

"You are a priest forever, after the order of Melchizedek."

In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered us prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to him who was able to save him from death, and he was heard for his godly fear. Although he was a Son, he learned obedience through what he suffered; and being made perfect he became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey him, being designated by God a high priest after the order of Melchizedek.

### **LUKE 18:9-14**

He also told his parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous and despised others: "Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, `God, I thank you that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, I give tithes of all that I get.' But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, `God, be merciful to me a sinner!' I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but he who humbles himself will be exalted."
