

COMMEMORATION OF THE APOSTLES ST. THADDEUS AND ST. BARTHOLOMEW, THE FIRST PREACHERS OF CHRISTIANITY IN ARMENIA

Apostles St. Thaddeus and St. Bartholomew were two of the twelve Apostles of Christ, who came to Armenia and preached Christianity in Armenia deserving the title "the first illuminators". Still at the dawn of Christianity they were martyred in Armenia. It was the result of their preaching and martyrdom that the Armenian people, being the first nation in the world, proclaimed Christianity as the state religion. Indeed, Apostles St. Thaddeus and St. Bartholomew played an important role in the history of 2000-year-old Christian Armenian nation which has unshaken faith and keen love towards its Mother Church.

13 Բազմութեան մէջէն մէկր րսաւ անոր. «Վարդապե՛տ, րսէ՛ եղբօրս՝ որ ինծի հետ բաժնէ մեզի ինկած ժառանգութիւնը»։ <u>14</u>Ան այ ըսաւ անոր. «Մա՛րդ, ո՞վ նշանակեց զիս իրաւարար կամ բաժնող՝ ձեր ոսաւ անոնց. «Ուշադի՛ր եղէք եւ զգուշացէ՛ք վրայ»։ 15Ապա ագահութենէ. որովհետեւ մէկուն ստացուածքներուն առատութենէն կախուած չէ իր կեանքը»։ <u>16</u>Առակ մրն ալ խօսեցաւ անոնց՝ ըսելով. «Հարուստ մարդու մր արտերը տուին առատ բերքեր, <u>17</u>եւ ան կր մտածէր ինքնիրեն՝ ըսելով. "Ի՞նչ ընեմ, որովհետեւ տեղ չունիմ՝ ուր բերքերս ժողվեմ"։ Եւ րսաւ <u>18</u>"Սա պիտի ընեմ. պիտի քանդեմ ամբարներս, պիտի կառուցանեմ աւելի՛ մեծերը, հոն պիտի ժողվեմ իմ բոլոր բերքերս ու բարիքներս, <u>19</u>եւ պիտի ըսեմ անձիս. «Ո՛վ իմ անձս, շատ բարիքներ ունիս՝ դիզուած շատ տարիներու համար. հանգչէ՛, կե՛ր, խմէ՛ եւ զուարձացի՛ր»"։ <u>20</u>Բայց Աստուած ըսաւ անոր. "Անմի՛տ, այս գիշեր անձդ պիտի պահանջուի քեզմէ. ուստի որո՞ւ պիտի րլյան այդ պատրաստած բաներդ"։ <u>21</u>Այսպէս է ան՝ որ գանձ կր դիզէ ինքնիրեն համար, բայց չի հարստանար Աստուծոյ մօտ»։ 22Եւ րսաւ իր աշակերտներուն. «Ուստի կր լայտարարեմ ձեզի. "Մի մտահոգուիք ձեր անձին համար՝ թէ ի՛նչ պիտի ուտէք, ո՛չ ալ մարմինին համար՝ թէ ի՛նչ պիտի հագնիք. <u>23</u>որովհետեւ անձր կերակուրէն աւելի է, մարմինը՝ հագուստէն։ <u>24</u>Դիտեցէ՛ք ագռաւները, որոնք

սերմանեն եւ ո՛չ կը հնձեն, որոնք ո՛չ շտեմարաններ ունին, ո՛չ ալ ամբարներ, բայց Աստուած կը կերակրէ զանոնք. դուք ո՛ րչափ աւելի կարժէք թռչուններէն։ 25Ձեզմէ ո՛ վ կրնայ մտահոգուելով կանգո՛ւն մը աւելցնել հասակին վրայ։ 26Հապա եթէ չէք կրնար ամենափոքր բանը փոխել, ինչո՞ւ կը մտահոգուիք ուրիշ բաներու համար։ 27Դիտեցէ՛ք շուշանները, թէ ի՛նչպէս կաձին։ Ո՛չ կաշխատին եւ ո՛չ կը մանեն. բայց կը յայտարարեմ ձեզի թէ Սողոմոն ալ՝ իր ամբողջ փառաւորութեան մէջ՝ չհագուեցաւ անոնցմէ մէկուն պէս։ 28Ուստի եթէ խոտը, որ այսօր դաշտի մէջ է ու վաղը փուռը պիտի նետուի, Աստուած ա՛յդպէս կը հագուեցնէ, ո՛րչափ աւելի ձե՛զ, թերահաւատնե՛ր։ 29Ա՛լ դուք մի՛ փնտռէք թէ ի՛նչ պիտի ուտէք եւ ի՛նչ պիտի խմէք, ու մի՛ շփոթիք. 30որովհետեւ աշխարհի ազգե՛րը կը փնտռեն այդ բոլոր բաները, եւ ձեր Հայրը գիտէ թէ ասոնք պէտք են ձեզի։ 31Հապա դուք խնդրեցէ՛ք Աստուծոյ թագաւորութիւնը, ու այդ բոլոր բաներն ալ պիտի տրուին ձեզի՝»։

LUKE 12:13-31

13Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." 14Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?" 15Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." 16And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man produced a good crop. 17He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.' 18"Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. 19And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of good things laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry." 20"But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' 21"This is how it will be with anyone who stores up things for himself but is not rich toward God." 22Then Jesus said to his disciples: "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; or about your body, what you will wear. 23Life is more than food, and the body more than clothes. 24Consider the ravens: They do not sow or reap, they have no storeroom or barn; yet God feeds them. And how much more valuable you are than birds! 25Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life? 26Since you cannot do this very little thing, why do you worry about the rest? 27"Consider how the lilies grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. 28If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today, and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, how much more will he clothe you, O you of little faith! 29And do not set your heart on what you will eat or drink; do not worry about it. 30For the pagan world runs after all such things, and your Father knows that you need them. 31But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well.
