# **Memory Among Ruins: Legacies of the Armenian Community of Van by Dr. Anoush Tamar Suni**



Anoush Tamar Suni is the Keyman Modern Turkish Studies Postdoctoral Fellow at Northwestern University. Prior to coming to Northwestern, she was a Manoogian Postdoctoral Research Fellow in the Armenian Studies Program and the Department of Anthropology at the University of Michigan. She earned her Ph.D. in anthropology from the University of California, Los Angeles, in 2019. She is currently working on her book project, which investigates questions of memory and the material legacies of state violence in the region of Van, focusing on the historic Armenian and contemporary Kurdish communities. Her research was recently published in *Comparative Studies in Society and History* and is forthcoming in *Anthropological Quarterly*.
